

Deuteronomy 1:3, 8

³ And it came about in the fortieth year, on the first day of the eleventh month, that Moses spoke to the children of Israel, according to all that the LORD had commanded him to give to them. ⁸ 'See, I have placed the land before you; go in and possess the land which the LORD swore to give to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to them and their descendants after them.'

“According to Pastor Mark Biltz of El Shaddai Ministries, Puyallup, Washington, President Bush has come to Israel on a very significant date to divide the land! There is an incredible Biblical connection between President Bush’s trip to Israel and a 3,500 year old event.
