

Genesis 6:3-4

3. Then the Lord said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless his days shall be one hundred and twenty years. 4. the Nephilims were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men, and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.

Verse 3 clearly speaks of God declaring that in one hundred and twenty years, His righteous judgment is coming to earth. Sometimes when we are in sin and nothing horrible happens right away, we start to believe that it must not be too bad. Deception enters quickly in, and before long we all can justify anything we want. I wonder if it was much different with these people so long ago, because there wasn't an immediate consequence to their choices.
