I recently heard one of the most disturbing pieces of news coming out of the church in a very long time. It is by permission of Mike Hein, and the Christian Civic League of Maine, that I share the following article in part with you. ***Congregational Denomination Reverends Sign Letter Supporting LD 1309*** *Nineteen Maine United Church of Christ Congregational Ministers signed a letter supporting abortion, and public funding of abortion, according to Maine's Health and Human Services Committee this week. The letter, dated April 11, 2007 and obtained this week by the League, was submitted as written testimony in the public hearing of LD 1309, "An Act To Provide Equity in Funding for Women's Health Services." This legislation seeks to provide \$283,272 per year in taxpayer dollars to publicly fund abortions in Maine. The letter quotes from Proverbs 29:7, and states in part, "...we recognize that some [Maine] women who cannot afford abortions turn to desperate means to end unwanted pregnancies. Our calling is to care for those who need our help the most. Our religious traditions teach us that life is sacred, and it is precisely because life and parenthood are so precious that we believe no [Maine] woman should be coerced to carry a pregnancy to term." Interestingly, nowhere in the letter do the Congregational ministers identify themselves as Christian, or belonging to a Christian denomination, or to the Church of Christ.
